## INFORMATION SOUGHT IN THEFT OF HORSES

Polk County Sheriff's Agricultural Crimes deputies are seeking information about the theft of horses that occurred in Frostproof on December 12, 2007.

Some time during the middle of the night, unknown suspect(s) cut a fence and entered the private property located at 155 Sand Pine Trail in Frostproof, removed three horses, loaded them onto a horse trailer, and fled undetected. All three horses are AQHA team penning/reining horses.

One horse is a dark brown bay mare, 15 hands high, medium build, with a sock on her left rear foot, star and snip on her face. Her name is Missy.

One horse is a brown sorrel mare, 15.2 hands high, stocky build, with a WW brand on her left hip, socks on both feet, and a broken stripe on her face. Her name is Harley.

One horse is a brown sorrel gelding, 14.2 hands high, stocky build, with a WW brand on his left hip, sock on his right rear foot, and a stripe on his face. His name is Perky.
